The Professor Harry Messel International Science School (ISS) is an educational programme run biennially by the Science Foundation for Physics. One hundred and forty Year 11 and Year 12 students make up the ISS scholars from countries including Australia, China, Japan, India, Malaysia, New Zealand, Singapore, Thailand, UK and the USA.

ISS students are selected in their home countries on their academic ability by their national scientific institutions and associations.

The ISS programme lecturers donate their time to teach these academically outstanding young scholars. Past ISS lecturers have included such notables as James Watson and Jerome Friedman, both Nobel Laureates, Sir Hermann Bondi, Thomas Gold FRS, Lord May of Oxford OM AC Kt PRS, Margaret Burbidge and more recently, in 2007, Professor Michael Oppenheimer and Lord Professor Robert Winston.
